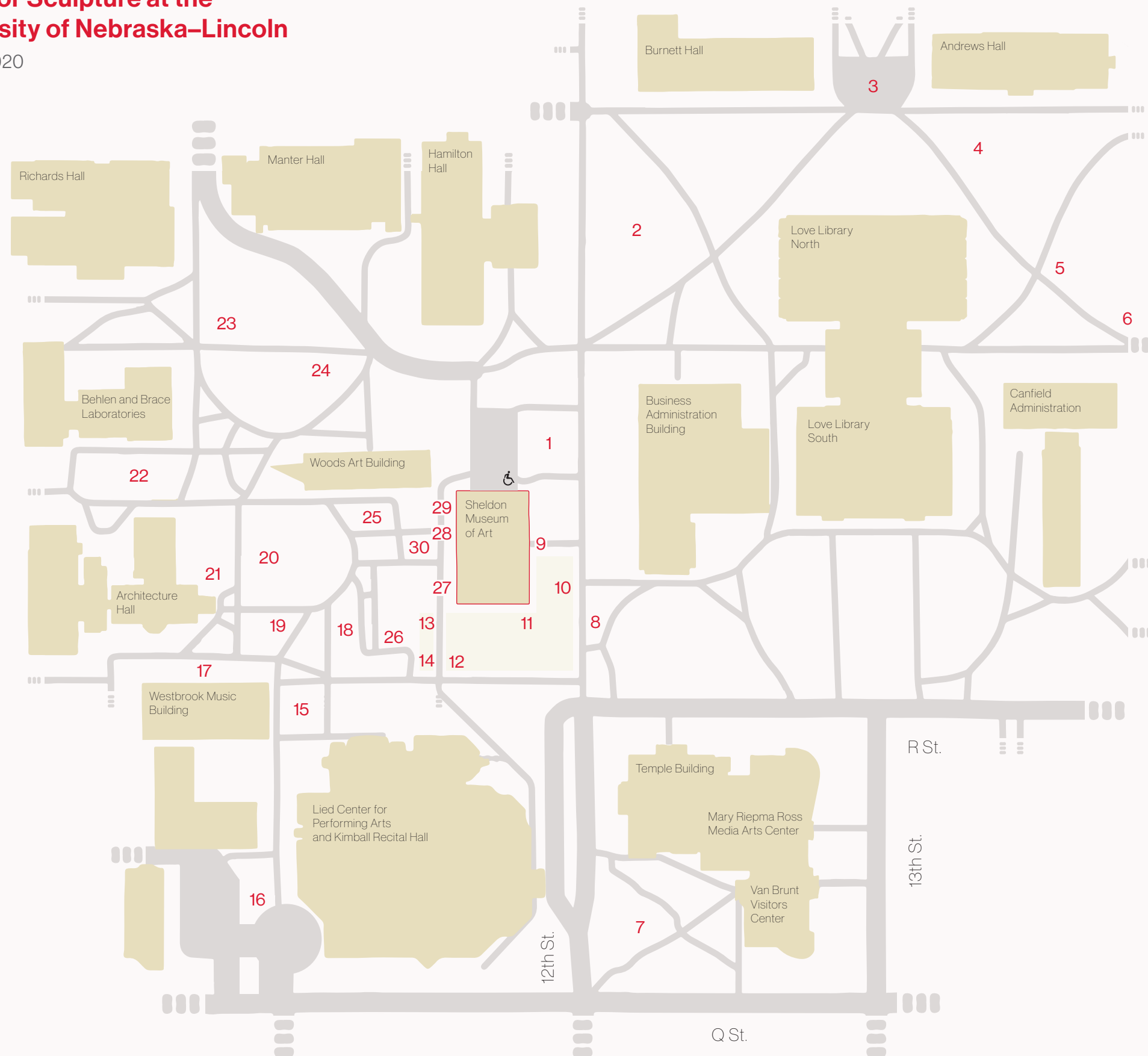


# Outdoor Sculpture at the University of Nebraska–Lincoln
