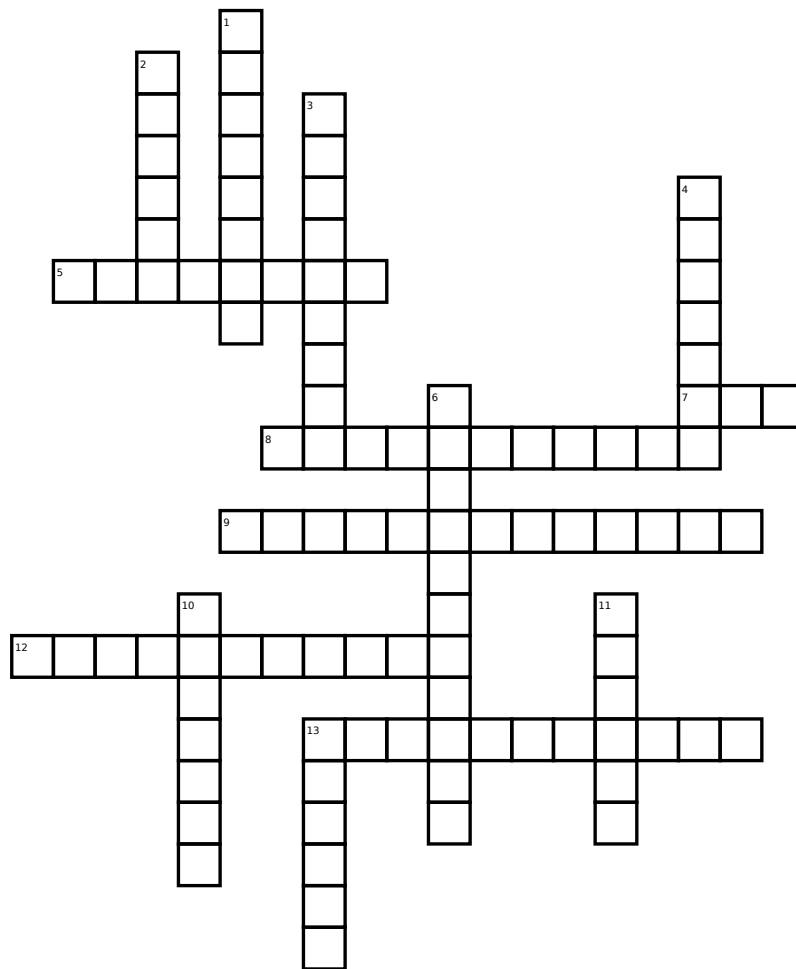


Sheldon Crossword
